Euromeet was started in Sweden by SARS in 1995 and the first meeting was arranged in Skara. In 2002 it was decided that the task of arranging this nice event should alternate between the clubs in Sweden (SARS), Finland (AMCCF) and Norway (RACN). RACN arranged their first Euromeet in 2004 at Tyriheim. This nice camping ground we had then already used for many years for our national events. In 2007 we arranged our second Euromeet, so now for the third time and 15 years after the initial start in Sweden, it is again our turn. Unfortunately Tyriheim has now shifted the focus to other areas and are no longer able to host arrangements like the Euromeet. But after a lot of searching, we now believe we have found an even better place. So take the trip to lovely Telemark this weekend and have a good time with a lot of like-minded people. This will be a great experience.

The place:

Bø is a small, friendly city in the heart of Telemark County about 2 hours by car from Oslo. The city is situated in a picturesque landscape and has a lot to offer of both activities and adventures. The city is also known to have a lot of car enthusiasts and for its hospitality. So it should be plenty of opportunities for both large and small. The city hall of Bø is located in the centre of the city and this is where we have planned to have the car show on Saturday in between stores, shopping centres, pubs, restaurants etc.

The camping ground:

"Beverøya Hytteutleie og Camping" is the name of the place we have rented for the weekend and the place to stay to join the rest of the crowd. The camping ground is located in just a walking distance to the centre of Bø and should be able to satisfy most demands. The place has its own beach and a big play ground for the kids. The cabins are ranging from the very simple, to quite luxurious.
